- Slide 1 – **Picture:** The huge wave
Words: December 26 – the day after Christmas – TSUNAMI
- Slide 2 – **Picture:** Huge devastation
Words: No words
- Slide 3 – **Picture:** More devastation
Words: The largest natural disaster since Noah and the flood – 300,000 people killed and still more missing
- Slide 4 – **Picture:** Of the relief efforts
Words: The response of the world has been overwhelming
- Slide 5 – **Picture:** Map of the whole Tsunami area
Words: Singapore can play a substantial role in the rebuilding
- Slide 6 – **Picture:** Map of Sumatra, concentrating on Aceh and Singapore
Words: Latest figures are that 120,000 dead with 100,000 missing presumed dead.
- Slide 7 – **Picture:** The US and other military working in Aceh
Words: Military forces from around the world have been working in Aceh to assist the relief efforts with great success
- Slide 8 – **Picture:** The military leaving Aceh
Words: On Feb. 28th the Indonesian government had all foreign military forces leave therefore leaving no heavy-lift capability for the relief and reconstruction of this devastated land
- Slide 9 – **Picture:** Singapore port facilities
Words: An excellent port near Aceh connected with the world is needed as a base for the reconstruction
- Slide 10 – **Picture:** Beaches of Aceh
Words: No workable ports in Aceh or few workable roads. Therefore a direct link needs to be made between Singapore and the beaches of Aceh
- Slide 11 – **Picture:** Of a US Navy LST
Words: RIA owned 5 LSTs used in a highly effective operation in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia where at times we handled 40% of the thru-put of the Jeddah port.

- Slide 12 – **Picture:** Of Dave Zornes and the HexaBlock
Words: We can build tens of thousands of houses all over Aceh especially in the most devastated areas within two kms of the beach. These would be built of RIA's material called nepheline syenite made into a polymer resin
- Slide 13 – **Picture:** A fishing boat – approximately 40 to 50 feet
Words: RIA is working on a design to replace the tens of thousands of fishing boats that were lost. We can build them rapidly out of the polymer resin in three moulds – the hull, the deck and the deck house. Like the much larger Liberty ships of World War II.
- Slide 14 – **Picture:** Map of Singapore and Aceh – showing route from Singapore around the coasts of Aceh
Words: Singapore could thereby become the center of tsunami aid and reconstruction. To get to Aceh people will go thru Singapore.
- Slide 15 – **Picture:** An LST tied up to a base anywhere with cargo being loaded
Words: For the above operation we need a water-side base in Singapore from which the LST could operate and trans-shipment of cargo can take place
- Slide 16 – **Picture:** Fishing boat building
Words: Later RIA will need a partnership with a boat building co. in Singapore to where we ship the already formed hulls, decks, deck houses and finished them with the engines coming in aid from Japan and Germany
- Slide 17 – **Picture:** General pic of Singapore water front
Words: Results of the operation: 1. Singapore does become the center of the tsunami reconstruction with all the favorable publicity that entails. 2. The tsunami survivors are assisted ENORMOUSLY.

Words: RIA and its products serve those survivors who have lost everything and greatly assist the international aid community to really do their job effectively.
